Alpine Report

Policy/process for add or cancelation of training days— How many athletes need to be present for us to run training? There is currently lack of clarity in the coaching contracts.

Formalizing complaint process— We need to consider creating a formal process for complaints to help identify what the problem is and what solutions there are going forward. Tabled. Kerensa to brainstorm some thoughts/ideas and bring forward to next meeting.

Coaching Report

NG Coaching in the near future— Coaching is at a turning point right now with the reality that our current coaches are parents of alpine children. Idea to start 'Pathway into Coaching Clinics' to train up parents into coaching positions. We are aiming for an 8:1 ratio for our coaches (26 athletes in jr alpine/alpine currently). We may think about developing the Advanced NG program next year which Karcsi would take on.

Ski the North NGSL Festival— Sat: dual glalom (Face) with jump (Rush), moguls (shaft) and speed trap. Sunday: mix kids up ages and clubs in groups 6-8 kids and do scavenger hunt. Coaches to set courses. In need of officials (those with more experience in key positions). Wireless timing for shaft? **Coach coverage for the rest of the season**— Feb 11/12 mock NG Fest race to be set, Karcsi, Kara, Tyler doing coverage.
