



Club Cabin use Guidelines

During the 2022 Season LCSC (Lightning Creek Ski Club) coaches, athletes and board members and general members must practice the guidelines set out by Via Sport and the Provincial Health Authority while in the LCSC club facilities. The current guidelines state that we must be fully vaccinated and masks must be worn inside all buildings unless separated by 3 meters. In our club cabin it is our responsibility to our athletes, members, staff and host resort to practice these guidelines. The consequences of not doing so could have serious consequences for members, the club and the resort. It is our responsibility to manage how we handle this health and safety guideline for everyone, please do your part.

We have spent significant time and effort to prepare the club cabin for use by our coaches and athletes to warm up on cold days. Athletes must have a mask to wear; a buff is not a mask. If we have athletes that are left without a place to eat at lunch because they don't have a place at the hill or don't have a parent that has stayed at the hill to provide them with a heated space to eat their lunch we can accommodate 8 people in total in the club cabin. That is 4 upstairs and 4 downstairs. Athletes will need to coordinate that with their coach in advance to have this access.

On Snow training

All on snow activities are to follow the resort protocols. The protocols are social distancing with masks on in the lift line, and only ride the lift with people in your cohort or bubble. In the case of our athletes this means you are entering into a 3 meter range which requires a mask or multi layer face covering. This is an area that we need to be super vigilant about because it is within the highest traffic areas of the resort. When we ski together we represent our Club and as a club we need to respect others that use the facilities at the resort by following the protocols the resort has in place at all times.

As club members we should all strive to be vigilant and follow the provincial guidelines inside and outside of club activities so that we can all have a safe and successful season.
